Our Father crushed His own Son for His good, and we trust His sovereign hand to bruise ours only exactly as much as he needs. Pain in a little one only reminds me that he is born with inher-



ited guilt, and is like us in desperate need for salvation. So please join us in praying that the Lord would save our children.



Ministry is flourishing on every front. I continue to preach a couple Sundays a month at different Spanish speaking churches, and we love the opportunity to interact with my students at a personal level. Also, the Institute is growing.
